will be pets and hearts. The Buds will work on counting, sequencing, and building vocabulary.

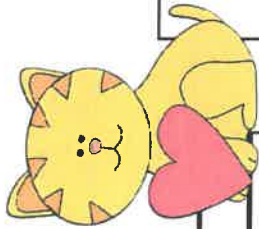
