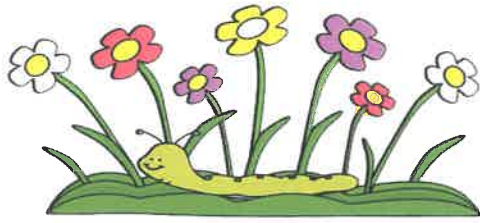

Wow we can't believe how fast April has gone by! Hopefully it will bring us lots of May flowers! During the month of April we had fun talking about and learning about transportation.

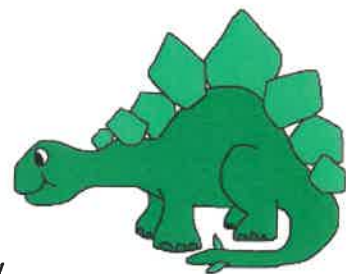
