Pig - Place the back of the right open hand under the chin and bend + unbend the hand several times represents being full and having eaten to the chin.

Cow - Place thumbs at the side of the head, fingers down and pinky up and twist hands up. (Or use only one hand) representing the horns.

Horse - Place pointed index and middle fingers at the sides of the head palms facing forward and move the fingers up and down representing the ears of the horse.

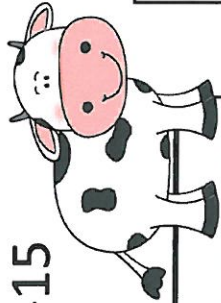
Now would be a good time to check your child's **cubby** for season and size appropriate clothing.... also, remember socks. For our new families here is a list of items to bring for your child:
