Happy February and hope you have a lovely **Valentine's Day!**



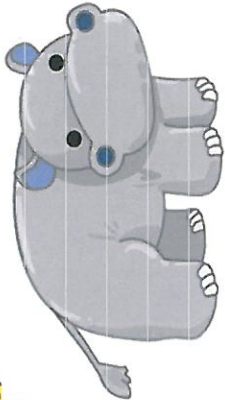
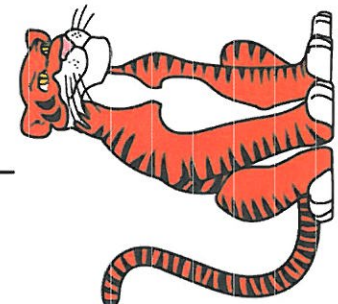
