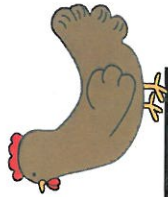
Once again, thank you for all you do and say. We really appreciate it. Please don't forget to bring extra clothes and if you have any questions or concerns about the room please come and talk to us.
