The farm animals keep interrupting her because they want her join their fun. Through this story the Buds learned about hard work and how it pays off. Herman the Worm was one of their favorite songs this month. In the song Herman eats all sorts of different things, and the Buds found it to be so funny. They also loved singing the Caterpillar song.

Speaking of caterpillars we experienced the life cycle of a butterfly in our classroom. Egg, larva (caterpillar), pupa(chrysalis) and then butterfly. **Ida** said, "They are eating so much to get bigger." After the caterpillars made their chrysalides **Hayden** counted them and said, "We have 4 chrysalides." **Grey** liked looking at the butterfly life cycle poster every morning and informed his friends what the next step in the cycle was, "Now it will turn into a beautiful butterfly" he said.

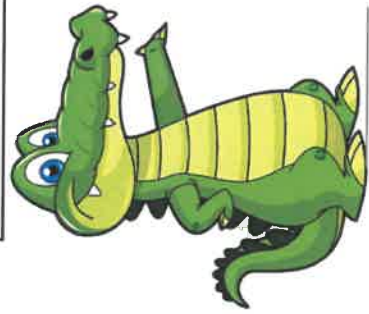
